Vandring 6- Guided tour in English

Guided walk: Norrtälje "the capital of Roslagen"

Anders Djerf, authorised Norrtäljeguide, will lead you through the medieval road network, pointing out buildings of interest.

During this guided walk you will learn more of a fascinating place with roots back in the early times, when vikings heading east – hear the history of Rurik and his sons journey year 862!

The town Norrtälje was founded in 1622 by Gustav II Adolf. The town were totally burned down by the Russians in 1719, but soon after rebuilt. Among the oldest woodenbuildings are Wallinska Gårdarna at Lilla Torget-square and the former Town Hall at Stora Torget-square. From the mid-19th century until 1930'th Norrtälje was one of the Baltic Sea's most popular spa resorts – known for its healing mud.

We have a look at public art in the old city center och stroll along the all year lively streaming water in the Norrtälje river. Not to forget one of it's kind: the living Pythagoras Industrial Museum, founded 1898, today including Children's Pythagoras – a creative experience. We walk up the Södra Bergen hill that offers fabulous, sweeping views of the town.

The guided walk start at the Lilla Torget square. Ends in the parc by the former Rifle factory, established in 1623.
